The policy for Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School states, "Students must have a physical examination prior to their enrollment in CORLHS. Immunizations must be current and on file at the school in order for the student to attend. Athletic physicals must be renewed each year a student participates in school-sponsored, extra-curricular athletics."

CORLHS has adopted the Department of Human Services Certificate of Child Health Examination for freshman or the IHSA Physical Examination Form if your child is planning on participating in sports and is a sophomore or above, and the Permission to Provide Emergency Services Form (on the bottom of this letter) as the official forms of the school. We must have on file the Health Examination Form and the Permission to Provide Emergency Services Form prior to the start of the school year. The IHSA form is only returned if your child is participating in extra-curricular sports and is a sophomore or above.
