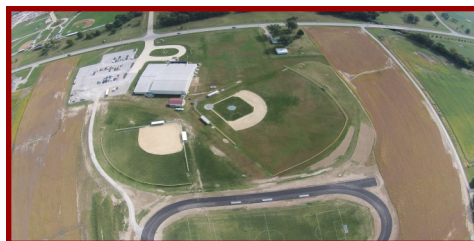

Tuition

- Basic Tuition - \$7,695 for 2024-2025
- Fees - \$50 application, \$150 registration
- \$1,000 Association Member Discount; \$500 Supporting Member Discount

- Need based tuition assistance and grants are used by most families.
- Tuition locks in at the rate of first enrollment.
